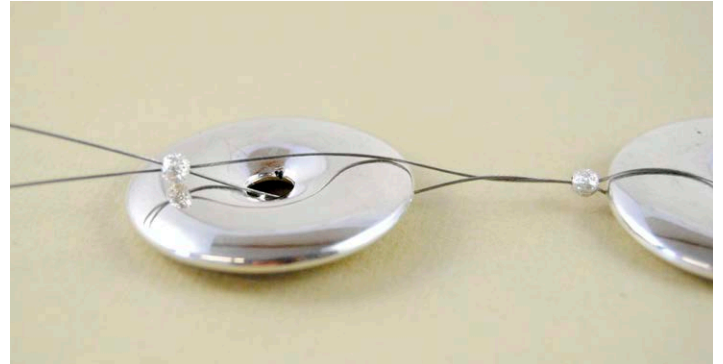


materials:

- 40cm Large link chain
- 4 x 30mm Flat rhodium donut beads
- 9 x 3mm Silver textured balls
- 2 x Crimps
- 2 x Crimp caps
- 40cm Tiger tail
- 4 x Medium jump rings

Tip: if preferred you can attach a large fancy toggle clasp and convert it into a bracelet.



instructions:

1 Take the tiger tail and fold it in half. Thread a jump ring that has been properly closed or if preferred, use a spacer ring. Thread both ends of the tiger tail through a crimp. Flatten the crimp and cover it with a crimp cover/cap. Thread a silver ball.

2 Thread the donut bead and a silver ball on the one piece of tiger tail. Centre the silver ball in the middle of the donut bead. Take the second piece of tiger tail and thread it from the opposite side of the donut bead, criss-cross inside the silver ball and exit on the other side.

3 Thread a silver ball onto both pieces of tiger tail. Push down firmly so that the donut bead and silver ball are firmly in place. Repeat step 2 for the next donut bead, followed by a silver ball. Repeat for the remainder of the donut beads.

4 After the last silver ball is threaded, thread a crimp followed by a jump ring that has been properly closed. Fold the tail back onto itself and pass it through the crimp

again. Pull down firmly so that the jump ring and crimp pushes firmly against the silver ball. Flatten the crimp. Trim any excess and cover the crimp with a crimp cap.

Attach the string of donut beads to the chain with jump rings. **CH**
